Every year applications are invited from students of the college in prescribed form. All the applications received are examined by the committee. The amount available in the Poor Boys Fund is divided and distributed to the eligible applicants.

Uniqueness –

71 poor students applied for this scheme and all are benefited. Total amount distributed Rs. 223000/- during the year 2023-24. Over the last three years 263 students were benefitted and Rs. 759500/- distributed.
